What Do We Find By Such Horoscopes?

- 1 No one has a bad day.** Of the 12 Zodiac signs listed: 6 had *dynamic* days; 4 had *positive* days; 2 had *average* days (10 signs out of 12 had a great day). Do the stars KNOW what kind of day I will have?
- 2 What is written is general, vague and open to many interpretations.**
- 3 The advice is positive and common sense.** There is nothing here that cannot be found in a fortune cookie, attitude tape or what your mother would say to you.

The Problems with Astrology

1. Astrology begins with the wrong date. Horoscopes are determined by date of birth. All hereditary factors are determined before birth.
2. Astrology is based upon the idea that the stars control our lives. Astrology denies free-will and is based upon the idea that everything is predetermined and set in life.
3. Astrology denies that change can happen. The Bible teaches otherwise. Hezekiah was going to die. He prayed to God. He was allowed to live 15 more years (2 Kg. 20:1-6). With astrology there is no need to pray because everything is determined.
4. Astrology is based upon the idea that the stars can tell future events. This is false. The Bible is to be our guide (Ps 119:105).
5. Astrology is driven by the desire to know the unknown. There are some things we do not know:
 - when Jesus is coming (Mt 25:13)
 - when world will end (2 Pet. 3:10)
6. God wants us to walk by faith (trust) and not be sight – or stars (1 Cor. 5:7).
7. Astrology fails scientific testing. *“Study after study has failed to support claims that astrology can predict the future or offer insights into personality. There is absolutely no merit to the basic claims that astrologers make.” He asked 26 respected astrologers to match the personality profiles of 265 people with their astrological charts. They were right only about 1/3 of the time. This is the same percentage as guessing.”* Shawn Carlson Lawrence, Berkeley Laboratories in Berkeley, CA

Bernie Silverman of Michigan State University studied 2,978 marriage and 478 divorce records. Those marriages which were considered perfect matches by the horoscopes and zodiac signs divorced just as frequently as those who were not compatible astrologically.
8. The local newspaper lists the following warning about the daily horoscopes: *Note: Horoscopes have no basis in scientific fact and should be read for entertainment, not guidance.”* (Kansas City Star)
9. Astrologers are not consistent (some say there are 8 zodiac signs, others say 12, and some 24).
10. God condemns the use of sorcery and soothsaying (Ex. 22:18; Rev. 21:8).
11. Early Christians burned their magic books (Acts 19:18-19). They searched the Bible not the skies (Acts 17:11). God wants us to follow Him.
